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### **Policies and Procedures:**

1. Applications will be accepted beginning March 15, 2008. Since there is a possibility of a limited number of tee times available at certain courses, entries will be determined on a first come basis.
2. All entries must be received 14 days prior to the event, in order to notify courses of tee times.
3. At the request of certain courses, some tee times will require a shotgun start. This info will be available at [piperglen.com](http://piperglen.com) (Piper Glen Jr. Tour).
4. Please print the application from the website and check the events you wish to play. Refunds will be granted for extreme medical or family emergencies.
5. Age division will be determined by your age as of August 1, 2008.
6. All players are required to walk and carry their clubs for 18 holes. Caddies are NOT ALLOWED and parents must remain at least 50 feet from their child. Parents are allowed to help find golf balls, however parents are not allowed to give advice.
7. A \$50.00 service charge for all checks returned for insufficient funds.
8. Players must play in at least 4 events in order to be eligible for the Piper Glen Tour Championship. The Tour Championship field will be determined by accumulated points in each individual event. The Top 12 in each division will be eligible to compete in the Tour Championship on August 7-8.
9. *Sterling Cut Glass* trophies will be awarded at each event. The number of trophies will be based on the number of entries in each division.
10. An overall Player of the Year, for both the boys and girls, will be based on overall performance, etiquette, and sportsmanship.
11. A \$500 scholarship (*Piper Glen Junior Tour Scholarship*) will be awarded to a boy and girl each season to help further their education (qualifications listed below).

### **Scholarship Details:**

- Awarded to a boy and girl who has completed their junior year of high school and has a letter of acceptance from an accredited junior college, college, or university. They must currently be playing the Piper Glen Junior Tour.
- All candidates MUST meet the following requirements in order to be considered for the scholarship...
  1. Have won a Piper Glen Junior Tour event
  2. Have played in at least four events during the current season
  3. Constantly exhibit proper etiquette and sportsmanship throughout the tour season
  4. Submit an application
  5. Provide the Scholarship Committee with a 200 word essay on why the game of golf and this scholarship are important to you.
  6. The recipients of this scholarship will be evaluated and chosen by the Piper Glen Junior Tour Scholarship committee.



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### CODE OF CONDUCT:

The Piper Glen Junior Tour is very thankful for the involvement of players, parents, and host facilities. The PGJT has established rules and guidelines for both its participants and their families.

It is required of all participants to adhere to the PGJT Code of Conduct while participating in any PGJT event:

1. **Attire:** When you arrive at the golf course you are expected to not only act like a golfer, but look like one as well.
  - Your appearance during competition should be in keeping with the following: tank tops, tee-shirts, short shorts, denim shorts, and jeans are not acceptable;
  - During play, collared shirts or mocks must be worn and tucked in at all times. Girls may wear sleeveless golf shirts.
2. **Regarding alcohol, tobacco, and drugs:** The use of any substances on or off the golf course will be considered a violation of the PGJT Code of Conduct leading to disqualification of/or suspension from the PGJT golf tournament(s) at the PGJT's absolute discretion.

A serious breach may include but is not limited to the following:

- abusive or inappropriate language
  - disrespect shown to course officials, volunteers, or golf professionals
  - throwing of clubs
  - notification of a PGJT official is required prior to leaving the golf course during a competitive round when withdrawing for any reason including medical,
  - mistreatment of the golf course in any way, will be considered a violation of the PGJT Code of Conduct
3. **Cell Phones:** Players are not allowed to use cell phones while competing on the golf course – all cell phones must be turned off and placed inside your golf bags. Breach of this rule is grounds for immediate disqualification.

The Piper Glen Junior Tour knows that you, as a player, know that golf is a game of integrity. By signing this Code of Conduct, you are indicating your desire to keep the great game of golf a great game, and to abide and accept this Code of Conduct and the PGJT's enforcement of this Code of Conduct.
