#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR MANAGER



## SWING TIP OF THE MONTH

The Putter Swing

Here is a pointer to help you make that putter swing more consistent.

The Triangle: Not every putting stroke is the same. But the most effective ones are repeatable and have only 1-2 moving pieces. Next time you make it out to the putting green, try to feel your arms hanging long and relaxed before gripping the putter. This will make a triangle with your arms like the picture below. During your putter stroke try to keep that triangle from breaking. Rock your triangle back and through without breaking your elbow or wrist angles that you set up with. This should help you simplify that putter swing.
